

Features

- 1) Input : Connects the electric guitar
- (2) Gain 1: Adjusts the amount of distortion in the Gain 1 overdrive channel
- (3) LED for Gain1: Indicates when Gain1 channel is in use
- (4) Gain Switch: Selects Gain1 or Gain2 channel in O.D. channel

- (25) Chorus LED: Indicates when chorus is ON
- (26) Depth: Adjusts the desired signal modulation
- (27) Rate: Produces a vibrato effect with Depth control turned up
- (28) Phones : Comnects a stereo headphone
- (29) Power Switch: Turns the amplifier ON or OFF
- (30) AC Inlet: Connects AC power cord.
- (31) Fuse Holder: Contains primary fuse.
- (32) Ground-Lift: Remove ground from the circuit to eliminate excessive 60 cycle num
- (33) External Speaker Jack : Connects the external speaker(s) with a minimum impedance of 40hm, and the internal speaker will be disconnected
- (34) External Speaker Jack : Cormects the external speaker(s) with a minimum impedance of 80mm.
- (35) Line Out : Connects a unit with line level input, e.g. mixer
- (36) Return Level : Controls the returning signal level
- (37) Return Jack : Connects the guitar amplifier to output of an effects unit

- (39) Send Jack : Cornects the guitar amplifier to input of an effects unit
